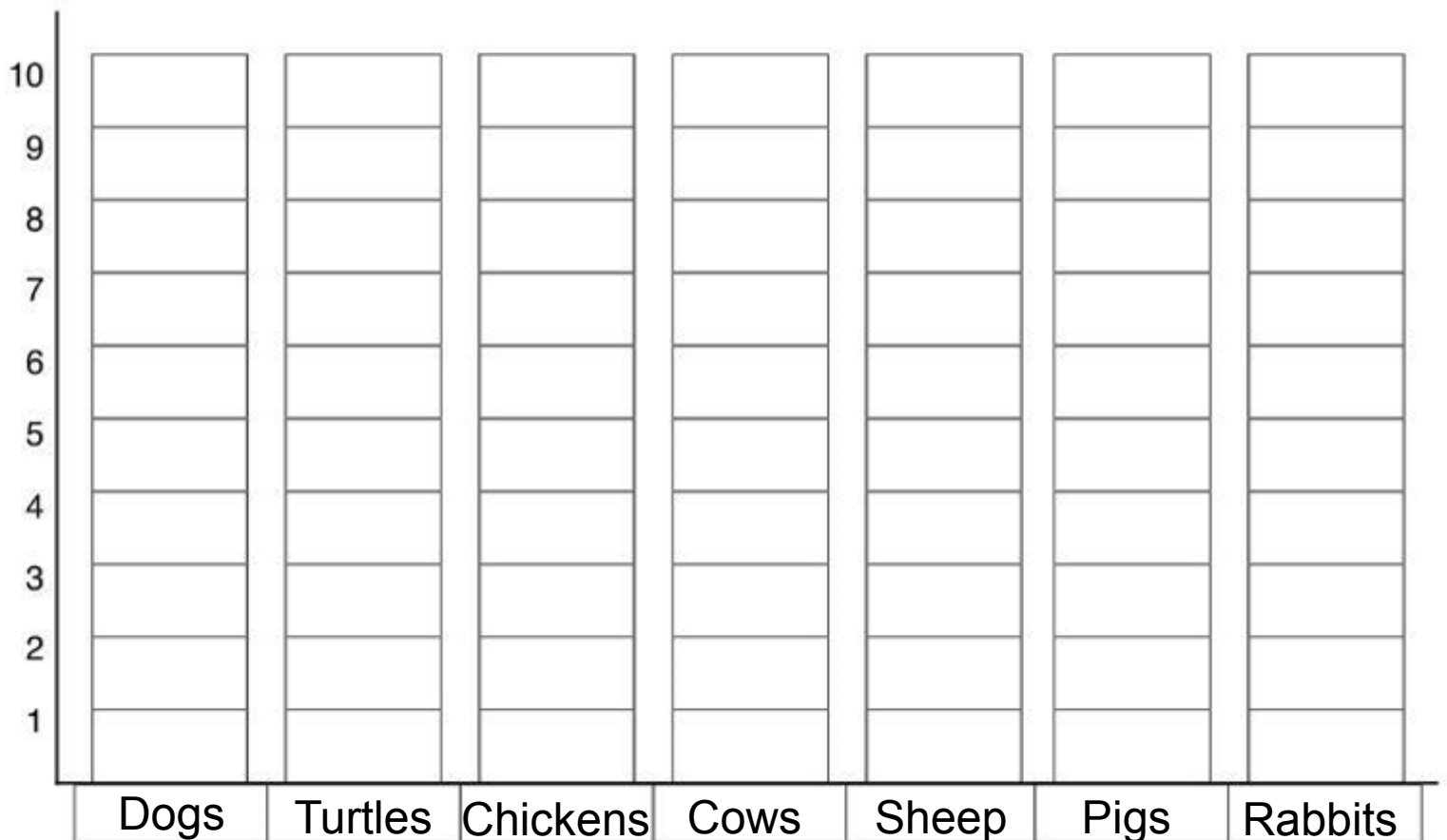

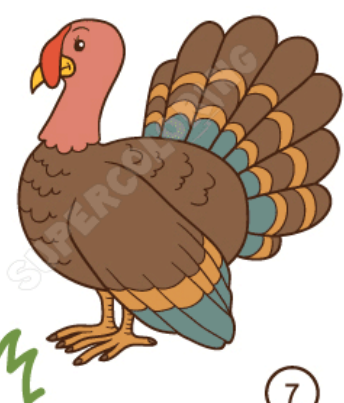
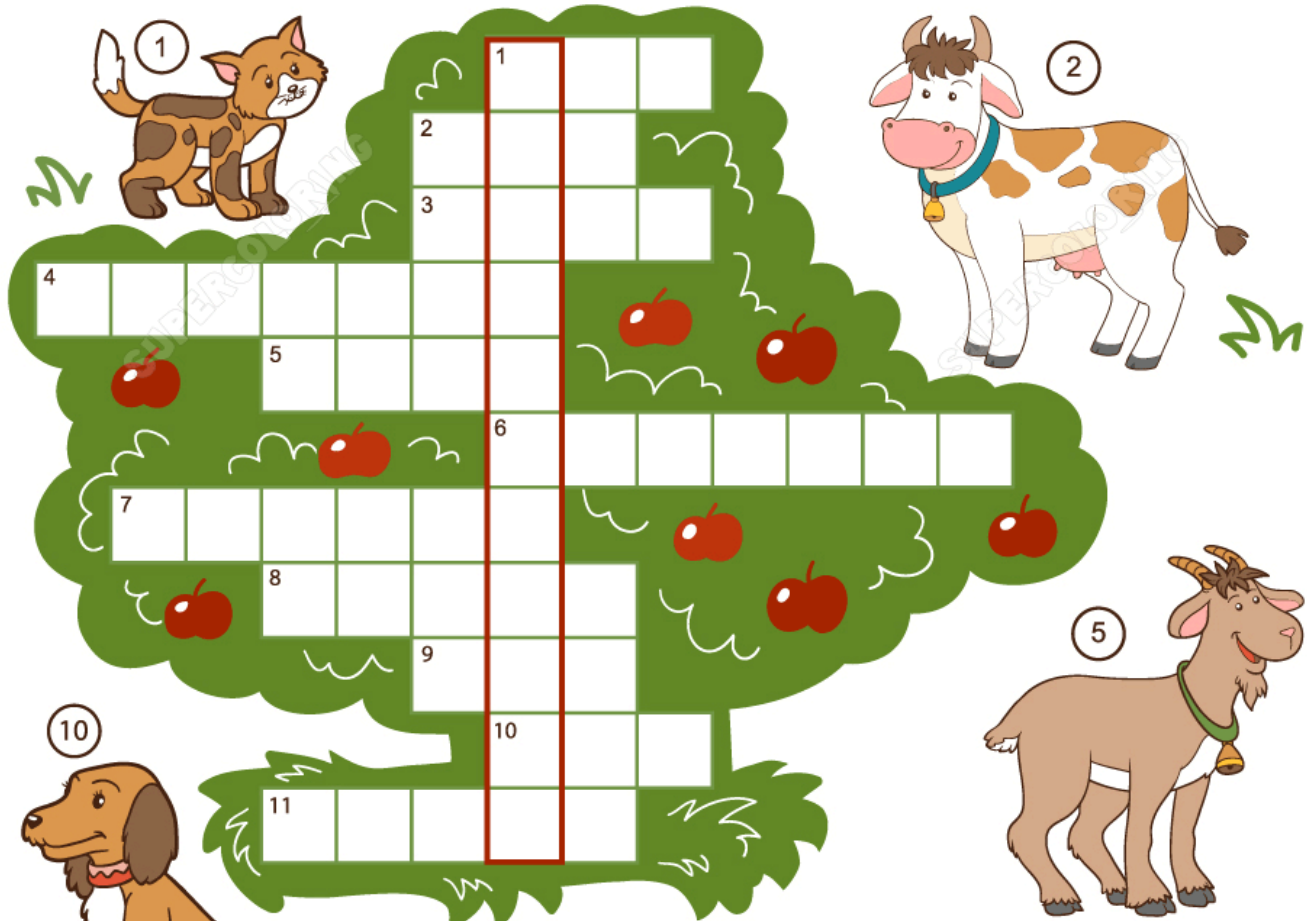
Animal Guessing Game

Player 1

1. This animal is the biggest species of the cat family. Many of its sub-species are endangered due to hunting and the destruction of its habitats. They can also jump over 5 meters in length. **Tiger**
2. Compared to other animals, this animal is very intelligent. They live in schools/pods of up to twelve. They also use a blowhole on top of their heads to breathe. **Dolphin**
3. This animal's habitat is found in African savannahs, grasslands, or open woodlands. Even though this animal has a very long neck, it contains the same number of bones in its neck as human necks. **Giraffe**

Player 2

1. These animals are the largest land-living mammal in the world. They sometimes use tusks for digging and finding food. They have large, thin ears to cool them down in hot climates. **Elephants**
2. This animal is the fastest land animal in the world. They are really fast but get tired fast as well, so can only keep up their top speed for a few minutes before they are too tired to continue. **Cheetah**
3. These animals are excellent hunters. These animals live and hunt in groups called a pack. The babies are born deaf and blind and it takes 8 months for them to actively join the pack hunts. **Wolves**

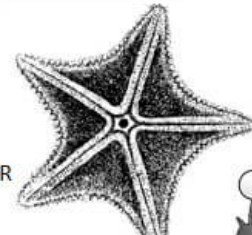
